Abiqua Drinking Gourd - Large round, puckered and deeply cupped blue leaves \$13
Abiqua Moonbeam - Blue green heart-shaped leaves edged with a wide yellow margin \$13
Allan P. McConnell - Small - Dense mound with thin white margins \$12
American Icon - L - Produces very large clump of green leaves with a wide gold edge; pale lavender flowers; dramatic accent plant \$20
ANN KULPA – L – Striking variegation pattern; specimen hosta; large heart-shaped leaves have a clean white center w/a chartreuse overlay where the center and green margin overlap; pale lavender flowers in midsummer. \$14
Big Daddy - L - 26-30" Large blue corrugated leaves; a very nice large blue hosta \$19
Blue Cadet - M - Forms dense mound of small bluish heart-shaped leaves; vigorous \$7
BLUE HAWAII – L – Upright vase-shaped blue corrugated leaves; white flowers. \$22
Blue Ivory – M - Wide creamy white margins and a blue center in spring; margins brighten to white and may develop a unique green blush; lavender flowers. \$25
Blue Mouse Ears - Small - Grey-green leaves; thick and soft \$18
Blue Umbrellas - L - Huge blue-green leaves; a fast growing plant that becomes giant \$14
BLUE WEDGEWOOD – M – Blue-green round, wedge shaped, cupped leaves, heavily seersucker. \$12
Brenda’s Beauty – M – Green margined leaves with chartreuse center; gorgeous! Pale lavender flowers \$25
Bressingham Blue - Large, puckered blue-green leaves; white flowers \$19
Bridegroom - M - Heart-shaped green leaves which curl upward while the sides of the leaf cascade downward. Purple flowers \$17

Brother Stephan - L - Large heavily corrugated gold leaves w/wide dark green margin; near white flowers top the thick leaves in early summer; spectacular \$17
Captain Kirk - M - Golden center contrasts nicely with darker margin; pale lavender flowers in midsummer; fast growing. \$17
Cherry Berry – M – Lance-shaped white leaves w/dark green margins; purple-blue flared flowers on clear red scapes; seed pods turn bright red and last through fall. \$22
Choo Choo Train - L - Thick gold leaves that are ruffled and in time will form a majestic clump 6 feet wide by 2 feet tall; near-white flowers in summer. Specimen plant. \$15
CORKSCREW – S – Glossy dark green leaves that are twisted and curled; pale lavender flowers; specimen plant for front of border. \$18
COUNTRY MOUSE – Mini – Tiny heart-shaped blue-green leaves w/pure white margin; forms miniature clump of foliage set close to the ground; lends itself for use in rock gardens, containers & along woodland pathways; lavender flowers. \$18
Cutting Edge - M - Fountain of ruffled leaf margins arched and folded to reveal their white backs; rippled blue-green foliage; lavender flowers in late summer. \$17
DANCE WITH ME – M-L – Yellow heart-shaped leaves framed w/dark green margin; heavy texture; pale lavender flowers. \$22
Dancing in The Rain - L - Leaves have large, pure white centers with blue-green margins; centers green up as the season progresses; pale lavender flowers. \$15
DANCING QUEEN – L – Broad wedge-shaped leaves of bright yellow w/rippled edge; lavender flowers. \$18
Dark Shadows - L - Features thick heart-shaped leaves w/gently ruffled edge; chartreuse-yellow margin in early spring but change to green by early summer; pale lavender flowers in early summer \$14

Daybreak- M-L - One of the deepest gold varieties; heavy texture and prominent veins; lavender flowers in summer; makes a nice accent or specimen plant \$10
Dick Ward – M – Bright gold leaves margined w/dark green edge; mature leaves exhibit heavy corrugation and puckering; mature clump is spectacular; pale lavender flowers. \$14
Dragon Tails - Mini - Forms a fast growing clump of long, narrow yellow leaves with a wonderful wavy edge; at home in a rock garden, trough or shaded woodland border; lavender flowers top the clump in midsummer \$15
EMPRESS WU – L – One of the largest hostas; makes a tremendous focal point; huge thick dark green deeply-veined leaves form a massive upright clump; pale reddish-violet flowers. \$20
Extasy - S-M - Creamy white wedge-shaped leaves with wide blue-green edge; upright growth habit; lavender flowers in midsummer. \$25
EYE CANDY – M-L – Blue-green; white margin; slightly rippled; lightly twisted/wavy/corrugated. \$22
Fair Maiden - M - Dark green leaf centers and streaky creamy white margin that eventually turns white; lavender flowers \$11
Faith - L - Thick-leaved gold; with maturity, develops rounded brassy-gold leaves with fantastic corrugation; near-white flowers top the vigorous clump in early summer; morning sun to lightly filtered shade results in the brightest leaf coloration; Choice! \$18
FAT CAT – L – 22High x 52Wide; heavy corrugated medium gold foliage; thick substance; lavender flowers. \$16
Fire Island - S - Brilliant yellow leaves accented by light red petioles w/red coloration extending into the base of the leaves; intense spring effect which lessens into the summer; lavender blooms top the clump in summer \$15
First Mate - S - Long wavy chartreuse leaves with dark green margin; dark lavender flowers in midsummer. \$22

Fried Green Tomatoes - 36-40", dark green heart-shaped leaves; fragrant white flowers \$12
FROSTED MOUSE EARS – Mini – Blue-green to dark green center w/wide creamy-white margin; thick substance; dense clusters of purple flowers. \$20
Ginko Craig - Small - White margined foliage; excellent border plant \$18
GINSU KNIFE – L – Wide medium green center w/intensely rippled and serrated yellow to creamy white margin; slightly fragrant whitish flowers. \$22
Gold Drop - S - Green-gold lance-shaped leaves that multiply quickly \$7
GOOBER – S-M – dark green, deeply puckered leaves; purple flowers. \$18
GRACILLIMA – Dwarf – Great for borders; small curly narrow green leaves. \$12
GUARDIAN ANGEL – L – Majestic; large blue-green leaves ruffled and folded; centered w/grayish-ivory variegation very intense in spring; no hosta collection complete without it; pale lavender flowers. \$20
HACKSAW – S – Long tapered light-green leaves that are intensely rippled and lightly serrated on the margins; incredibly vigorous growth rate; good sun tolerance; makes a nice edging plant; lavender flowers. \$18
Hadspen Blue – Very upright lance-shaped slightly cupped steel-blue heavily textured leaves; slug resistant; pale lavender flowers mid-summer. \$20
Hanky Panky - S – Unusual hosta; emerges in spring w/dark green leaves edged w/pale lime edge; ivory halo separates center from margin; center brightens to creamy-yellow as summer progresses; margin changes to near white \$21
Haydons Sunset - Small - Lime-green mound; great edger; florific \$15
HEATWAVE – M-L – Thick blue leaves w/central yellow interior; mature leaves develop heavy corrugation; near-white flowers. \$14

HI HO SILVER – S – Mounded form, medium green with pure white margin; slightly rippled.

High Society - S - Leaves emerge in spring with warm yellow center which brightens to white by midsummer; leaves are edged by a wide blue margin; pale lavender flowers late summer. \$16

HIS HONOR – M-L – Medium green; greenish yellow margin; slightly rippled; lavender flowers.

Hollywood Lights - L - Large arching dark green leaves accented by a yellow flare in the center of the leaves; dome shaped leaves form a large clump; pale lavender flowers in midsummer. \$18

HOLY MOUSE EARS – Mini – Wide bluish-green margin; yellow to creamy white center; thick substance; dense clusters of purple flowers. \$20

Honeybells - Heart shaped light-green leaves; fragrant white flowers; very large plant with good sun tolerance \$10

IONA Grayish-green leaves w/ a cream edge. \$12

ILLICIT AFFAIR – S-M – medium green; golden yellow margin; lightly wavy; nearly round; leaves emerge yellow and center turns green. \$15

Journey's End - L - Heart-shaped leaves with gently ruffled edge; yellow-gold leaves w/wide dark green margin that bleeds into the gold center; pale lavender flowers in midsummer. \$25

June - M - 12-18" Gold leaves with blue-green margins and markings \$18

Key West - L - Bright gold heart-shaped leaves are very large and form a clump that will reach over six feet across; bright filtered shade gives the most intense color; lavender flowers in early summer; choice. \$23

Krossa Regal - Large frosty-blue leaves; lavender flowers \$13

LAKESIDE BEACH CAPTAIN – L – Yellow centered w/wide blue-green margin; thick substance; pale lavender flowers. \$20

LAKESIDE KALEIDOSCOPE – M – Creamy white margins; green centered foliage. \$19

Lakeside Looking Glass – Glossy deep green leaves with distinctively rippled edges emerge yellow-green in spring; lavender spider-shaped flowers in late summer. \$20

Lakeside Shore Master - L - Emerges with blue-green leaves then develops rich yellow centers; mature leaves are thick and seersucker; pale lavender flowers. \$16

Lemon Frost - Small - Wide chartreuse center with pure white margin \$22

Liberty - M-L - Regal vase shape; large thick frosty blue leaves w/wide creamy yellow margin that fades to creamy white later in season; lavender flowers \$19

LOLLAPALOOZA – M-L – Dark green center w/wide bright yellow to creamy white margin; good substance; whitish flowers. \$22

MASQUERADE – Mini – Perfect for the front of the shaded rock garden or trough gardens; forms clumps of white-centered leaves edged w/green; flashy hosta; purple flowers. \$10

May-S-M - Golden form of 'June'; heavy substance; intense color; adds a splash of sunshine to the woodland border \$12

Mildred Seaver - M - Forms nice mound of leaves w/thick creamy-white margin and medium green centers; rapid growth rate \$10

Mississippi Delta - L - Large blue-gray leaves displayed horizontally; deeply impressed veins; can reach five (5) feet! White flowers \$15

MOURNING DOVE – L – Low spreading mound of blue-gray leaves w/silvery-white back; creamy yellow margin; interesting combination of leaf shape/color/form; pale lavender flowers. \$15

Northern Exposure - 24-28" Large blue-green leaves with white margins \$21

ORANGE MARMALADE – L – Wide blue-green margin; center bright gold becoming lighter during the season with bright light; pale lavender flowers. \$20

Paradigm – L – Beautiful gold leaves edged w/blue-green margin; variegation intensifies later in the spring; lavender flowers. \$10

Paul's Glory - L - Light green to creamy leaves with a dark green border in an irregular pattern; a stunning specimen plant \$19

PEANUT – Mini – Wide dark green margin streaks into creamy yellow white center; heavily corrugated; purple flowers. \$16

Pineapple Upside Down Cake - Narrow bright gold leaf with narrow dark green margin \$18

Popcorn - S- Produces rounded yellow leaves with a nice blue border; pale lavender flowers; with maturity, leaves develop cupping \$20

Praying Hands – S-M – Upright narrow leaves rolled and folded into a tube shape; thin white margin. \$19

Queen of the Seas - L - Features pointed heart-shaped leaves w/piecrust margin; heavily corrugated, twisted, blue-green leaves; near white flowers \$20

Rainforest Sunrise - S - Each thick gold leaf is margined by a dark green edge; pale lavender flowers in early summer. \$18

RASCAL – L – Wide chartreuse margins; medium gold center; good substance; lavender flowers. \$18

Red October – M – Blue-green leaves w/red petioles; lavender flowers. \$19

Regal Splendor – Upright vase-shaped heart-shaped puckered grey-green leaves with irregular creamy margins; lavender flowers. \$20

Remember Me - M - Leaves emerge yellow w/a narrow dark blue-green margin; center brightens to cream in summer; lavender flowers. \$15

Reptilian - M - Puckered semi-cupped, heavily substanced leaves w/piecrust edge; red leaf petioles and flower stems; light lavender flowers \$13

St. Paul - M-L - Sport of Paul's Glory; thick gold heart-shaped leaves bordered by wide blue-green margin; pale lavender flowers top the clump in early summer \$20

Sagae – L - Large thick wedge-shaped frosty-blue leaves with bold cream to yellow margins; pale lavender flowers mid-summer \$20

Satisfaction - L - Dark leaves with dramatic wide gold margin and good substance; forms wide low mound; near-white flowers in midsummer. \$13

Sharmon – M-L – slight undulation; variegated; blue-green margin. \$9

SPELLBOUND – M – medium yellow; white margin; slightly rippled. \$22

Spilt Milk - M-L- Features white streaks and splashes that spill over green heart-shaped leaves \$20

Stained Glass – M-L – Mounding form; bright variegation maintained throughout the season; brilliant gold; prominent veins give it a stained glass window effect; large near-white fragrant flowers. \$22

Stripease - M - Green leaves with a narrow band of white around a gold center \$20

Sum and Substance - L - Chartreuse foliage early in season – changing to golden later in season; slug resistant; very large plant \$15

SUMMER LOVIN – L – Green center; wide gold margin; thick substance; pale lavender flowers. \$22

SUNDANCE – M – Gray-green leaves with irregular margins of ivory-white. \$12

Sun Power - Bright gold leaves; very large plant with good substance and sun tolerance \$12

SUNLIGHT CHILD – Dwarf – Shiny yellow leaves w/red stalks. \$14

Sunshine Glory - L - Fabulous large green corrugated leaves edged w/wide gold margin; white flower scapes; lavender flowers; requires bright filtered light or morning sun to maintain its vigor \$14

TEATIME – L – bluish-green center changing to dark green; chartreuse to medium-gold margin; pale lavender flowers. \$20

Wheaton Blue - Medium sized blue-green; lavender flowers \$12

Whirlwind - M - Very streaky yellowish-white leaves edged by very dark green margins; variegation most pronounced in spring; lavender flowers in midsummer. \$15

Winfield Blue - M - Intense silvery blue narrow leaves with good substance form a wavy mound; pale lavender flowers. \$12

WORLDLY TREASURE – M – Wide, shiny, cupped green leaves; distinctly pointed; pale lavender flowers. \$15

Zounds - Bright gold; heavily corrugated leaves; large plant; good slug resistance \$14

In addition to this listing, a large selection of other hosta varieties will be available at the farm

Mini	Less than 7 inches
S-Small	7 - 18 inches
M-Medium	15 - 22 inches
L-Large	Greater than 22 inches

HOSTAS

“Hostas are plants grown for their wonderful foliage of infinite variation. Depending on the species or cultivar, the hosta can have blue, green, yellow or variegated leaves in a wide variety of shapes, sizes and textures. The plants may be grown separately or mixed with other plants that like the same conditions. Hostas appear in early spring and disappear in late fall and are hardy to Zone 3. The hosta also has the grace to produce a very acceptable flower in colors ranging from white to pale lavenders and blue-purples.”

The hosta without a doubt is a perfect perennial!
